GAMBELA COMMUNITY BOREHOLE



or seven years, and despite the recent rains, Northern Kenya has endured the harsh grip of drought. The once predictable monsoon rains have become erratic, leaving farmers struggling to plant and crops withering under the relentless sun. The **Gambela community**, nestled in Isiolo County, faces a serious food scarcity crisis after three consecutive failed seasons. The Improving Lives Initiative, in partnership with the Rotary Club of Laikipia Highlanders, has installed a solar powered 4kW Dayliff borehole pump which produces 21,000l of water per hour.

This dependable source of water is a lifeline, offering not just sustenance but a chance to rebuild. The borehole, at 100 meters deep, provides a steady flow of water for irrigation and daily needs. With this reliable source, Gambela can finally look forward to a future free from the fear of thirst and hunger.

LOCALLY ASSEMBLED LITHIUM BATTERIES



&S Manufacturing Dept have successfully completed a pilot assembly of Lithium-Ion battery packs. The goal of the project was to onshore Lilon battery manufacturing for product use of energy (PUE) applications in the region. The initial production run consists of two battery pack sizes (1.2kWh 24V, 2.4kWh 48V) of Lithium Iron Phosphate. The batteries feature integral battery management systems and are matched to Dayliff Ultraverter and Growatt multifunction inverters with principal applications for solar power system storage and mains power supply backup.

&S has extended its Digital Ingineering Solutions segment range in partnership with Delta Electronics to include Uninterrupted Power Supplies(UPS) for mission critical use cases and Data Centre monitoring systems.
