Looking ahead to the new year the prospects are encouraging. The Group is well resourced with many new and interesting initiatives in hand and the region's economic environment is more settled. Barring any unanticipated environmental developments, I look forward to a year of progress, particularly operationalising the Tatu Engineering Centre, as we focus on our theme 'Building on Strengths'

To provide a sustainable solution, D&S installed a 2.2kW **solar-powered borehole pump**, energised by 11 high-efficiency solar panels, ensuring a consistent and reliable water supply.
